John Murray (writer) John Murray (11 August 1866 – 11 May 1925) was an English author and publisher. Life and career Murray was born in Sydney, Australia, to Alexander Murray (a master mariner) and Mary Murray, née Halliday. Murray received little formal education and began writing at the age of 14. After moving to England in 1884, he began working for his uncle's publishing company, John Murray & Co., where he worked as an assistant to his uncle, Lord Murray, and later to John Murray, the founder and managing director of the firm. In 1901 Murray married Susanna Blunt, sister of the poet Elizabeth Browning and the couple had a son. Murray was an atheist, and became a close friend of the radical American writer Upton Sinclair. Murray died at the age of 57 at "Long Barn" (his home in Marden), which he purchased with the 82157476af
